SPECIAL NOTICES:

Only Golf Australia Handicaps will be used, and each player's correct handicap is her personal responsibility.

The G.V.L.G.A. Inc. Match Committee reserves the right to ascertain certification of a player's Golf Australia Handicap from her Club.

CONDITIONS:

Competitions will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St. Andrews, subject to such Local Rules as are in force on the course, over which the competition takes place.

The G.V.L.G.A. Inc. Match Committee will have the entire management of the meeting and will have full power to alter or make variations in the Conditions of the program, including settling any dispute or protest.

Any player not ready to hit off at her notified time, may be allocated a later starting time, and a substitute appointed.

Scratch Events take precedence over Handicap Events.

In the event of a tie in the Scratch Event, if time permits, there will be a Sudden Death Play Off. If time does not permit, the result will be determined by countback, as per Golf Australia Year Book. Ties in the Handicap Events will be decided by Countback, as per Golf Australia Year Book.

The Golf Australia Standard Conditions of Entry, which include Accidents, Drugs and Personal Risk, will apply.

Motorised transport is permitted under the following conditions "player who is disabled and unable to play without the use of a cart or bike, must obtain a Doctor's Certificate, and the approval, *at the time of entry*, of the G.V.L.G.A. Inc. Committee". Permission is also dependent on the Host Club's restrictions.

Professionals or family members are not permitted to caddy.

Trophy limit is ONE trophy per player.

The use of Distance Measuring Devices may be used in accordance with the Golf Victoria Standard Conditions of Entry, for All Golf Victoria Tournaments. Condition No. 13.

Players/caddies are permitted to make phone calls from the course to the Clubhouse or Rules Official for Rules/Emergency Assistance. Mobile phones must otherwise be switched off. Unauthorised use of a mobile phone will be considered a serious Breach of Etiquette, and the G.V.L.G.A. Inc. Match Committee may impose a Penalty under Rule 33 - 7.

Participants (competitors) acknowledge that any images (photos) taken during the tournament, may be used by G.V.L.G.A. Inc., for publicity and promotional purposes.
